Build a vibrant, sustainable volunteer base by engaging new participants and maintaining current contributors.


<u>Fundraising</u>

Why Do We Fundraise?

At KCH Elementary, our PTO is dedicated to fostering connection, community, and support. We're here to enrich the educational experience for our students, bring families together, and uplift the amazing staff who make it all possible.

The Field Trip Fund

With pandemic-era funds were no longer available, the PTO was asked to cover the local share of field trips for KCH scholars in all grades. This means we fund the remaining balance after applicable grants, ensuring that all students have access to valuable learning opportunities. Contributions to this fund directly support enriching educational experiences beyond the classroom. Our fundraising goal In 2025-26 is \$5,000.

The Robert Montgomery Fund

Named for beloved KCH principal Mr. Montgomery, this fund was established in 2023. The Robert Montgomery Fund provides year-round, no-questions-asked support for students and families within our district. Through gift cards and personal care items, the fund helps meet immediate needs while ensuring that all assistance is given with dignity and care. The PTO works closely with school social workers, psychologists, administrators, and staff to identify families in need of emergency support, with all recipients remaining completely anonymous. Established in honor of the strong, meaningful relationships Mr. Montgomery has built with Marcellus families, this fund has become an important way to support our community with compassion and respect. Our fundraising goal in 2025-26 is \$2,500.


